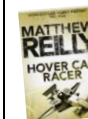
Letter to Author

Remember to investigate history, origin, meaning and how it changes a base word.

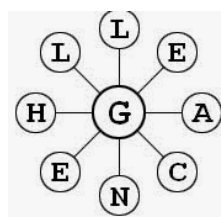
Cover it!
