Dear Parent/Guardian,

Gembrook Primary School is looking forward to another great year of teaching and learning and would like to advise you of the student voluntary financial contributions for 2024. No payments are expected until 2024.

Schools provide students with free instruction to fulfil the standard Victorian Curriculum and we want to assure you that all contributions are voluntary. Nevertheless, the ongoing support from our families ensures that our school can offer the best possible education and support for our students. We want to thank you for all your support, as it has made a huge difference to our school and the programs we can offer.

These contributions consist of:

- 1. Curriculum Contributions: Stationary, subscriptions, ICT & work sheet photocopying
- 2. Other contributions: Grounds maintenance and Building Fund.

And opt-in/pay as you go activities and items consisting of:

3. Extra-curricular items or activities: Excursions, incursions, yearbook, swimming (Grades Prep – 6), camps (Grade 2-6), graduation (Grade 6) and interschool sport (Grade 5 & 6).

Within our school the support of our families has allowed us to provide consistent materials for all students, a greater range of learning materials and experiences across all year levels, access to ICT equipment and computer applications, and to maintain and beautify our school grounds. The Building Fund is slowly growing with the purpose of upgrading school infrastructure, it was last used to extend the gym to add storage areas, including a dedicated space for the Human Powered Vehicle program equipment.

Department of Education and Training guidelines now mandate that schools are unable to provide parents with a statement of fees. We ask that you please review the recommended voluntary financial contributions schedule attached for an indication of recommended contributions for your child/ren.

Please complete this form and return to the school by <u>December 4th this year</u> so that the school can prepare the plan for 2024. Parents will be notified once payment options for 2024 are available on the Compass school app, payments are not expected this year.

3. Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Gembrook Primary School offers a range of optional items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides to deliver the Curriculum. Optional Swimming:

The program takes place in term 4 and aims to develop water safety, confidence and swimming ability. Payment plans available.

Optional Excursions and incursions to be scheduled:

Approximate total cost: \$80

Request for participation with an exact cost 2 weeks prior to each event.

Optional Camps:



The Gembrook Camp/Outdoor Education Program endeavours to promote the development of a child's independence and self-reliance skills, in addition to fostering such social skills as co-operation, tolerance, leadership and environmental awareness.

Three Camps are available including the Grade 2, Grade 3 & 4 and Grade 5 & 6 Camps. It is expected that in 2024 camps will range from around \$80 for the Grade 2 camp and up to \$370 for the 3 days/2 night camps for grades 3 - 6. Payment plans will available.

Optional Year 5 & 6 Interschool Sports program:

Approximate total cost \$160 if your child participates in all events.

Request for participation with an exact cost 2 weeks prior to each event.

Optional Grade 6 jacket: approximate cost \$25 subsidised

Optional Grade 6 graduation event: Approximate cost \$30.00

ONE PAGE OVERVIEW



FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements in Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.

PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:



Curriculum Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum.

Other Contributions

Voluntary financial contributions for non-curriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives.

Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

 Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).



FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.



SCHOOL PROCESSES

 Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.
